

Mediation

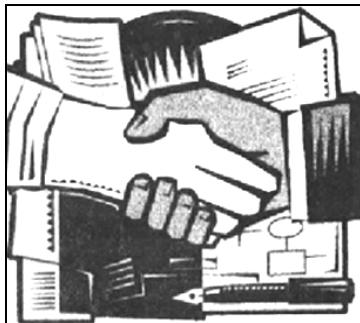

What is Conflict?

Conflict arises when two or more people perceive that their needs, or the strategies used to meet their needs, are in opposition.

What is Conflict Management?

Positive conflict management techniques are based on the idea that, by working together, people in conflict can develop solutions in which everybody's needs are met.

What is Mediation?

Mediation is a process for resolving disputes in which a neutral third party, the mediator, helps the disputants to articulate their needs and to reach a mutually acceptable solution to the conflict. All mediations are private and confidential.
